

Capital District Challenge League - Payment, Safety and Social Distancing Protocol

I. Safety Protocol

1. Masks are required to be worn at all times except seated consumption of food or beverage.
2. If you have any cold or flu-like symptoms of fever, runny nose, sneezing, cough, please stay home.
3. Anyone displaying obvious signs of physical distress will be sent home immediately.
4. Do not touch anyone or their bowling equipment. Try to keep a 6 foot distance when possible.
5. Do not put anything on the scoring console, this includes towels and rosin bags.
6. Leave rosin bags at your chair. A separate area for towels will be provided.
7. No bowling equipment or personal items in the bowling area unless you are seated on the off-lane bench.
8. Please place all bowling gear and personal items under or next your chosen chair for the night.
9. Do not go to the snack bar or bar, servers will take orders for direct delivery to you.
10. Any intentional threat to someone's personal safety means immediate forfeiture of all scores and earnings for the night with no refund and indefinite suspension.

II. Social Distancing

1. 4 players per pair max with only 1 lane of the pair being used. Please spread out where possible.
2. Once you arrive at your pair, you remain in your pair's slotted area until the end.
3. 1 spectator per youth bowler only. No other spectators are allowed.
4. Youth bowlers are classified as bowlers accepting prizes as scholarship.
5. Family members can sit next to their youth bowlers as long as they both are 6 feet from anyone else.
6. Pick one place to sit for the night in accordance with the seating chart. No musical chairs.
7. No intermingling between pairs, except socially distant 6 foot or more cross talk.
8. Only after the previous player has cleared the walking path, can the next person go bowl.
9. Get LIVE scoring updates using your smartphone on <http://www.cdclbowling.com> under Menu / CDCL Live.

III. Electronic Payments

1. Only electronic payments are accepted. Payouts will be via Venmo or USBC SMART scholarship only.
2. A one time payment can be made with cash or credit card at the desk if you dont have a Venmo account.
3. After the one time desk transaction you are expected to set up Venmo or league entry will be denied.
4. Using someone else's Venmo account to pay for your fees is OK but prizes will be sent to their account.
5. If you are owed a cash prize, the desk will cash you out after communicating with the league director.
6. Electronic prize payouts will be sent 1-2 days after the completion of the league night.
7. Special requests like lane assignments and bowling with friends can be made in the Venmo payment.
8. Please pay ahead if possible, this helps align the participants faster allowing us an earlier start.
